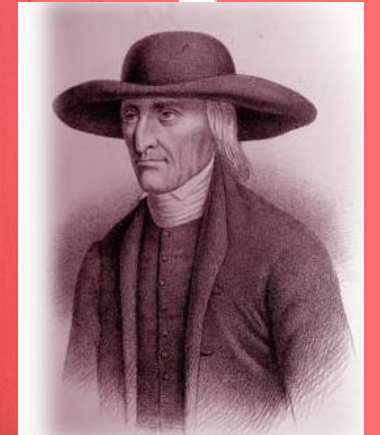

Learn about the foundations of the North Carolina Colony and what life was like for settlers in the Albemarle Region of Colonial North Carolina. The Newbold-White House Historic Site tells the story of Abraham and Judith Sanders, a Quaker Family, from 1730 to 1750. Today, this architectural gem stands as the oldest brick house in North Carolina- with much of the original structure intact.

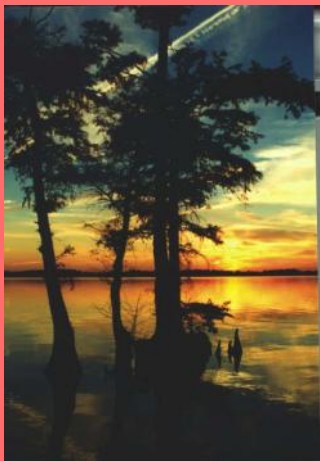

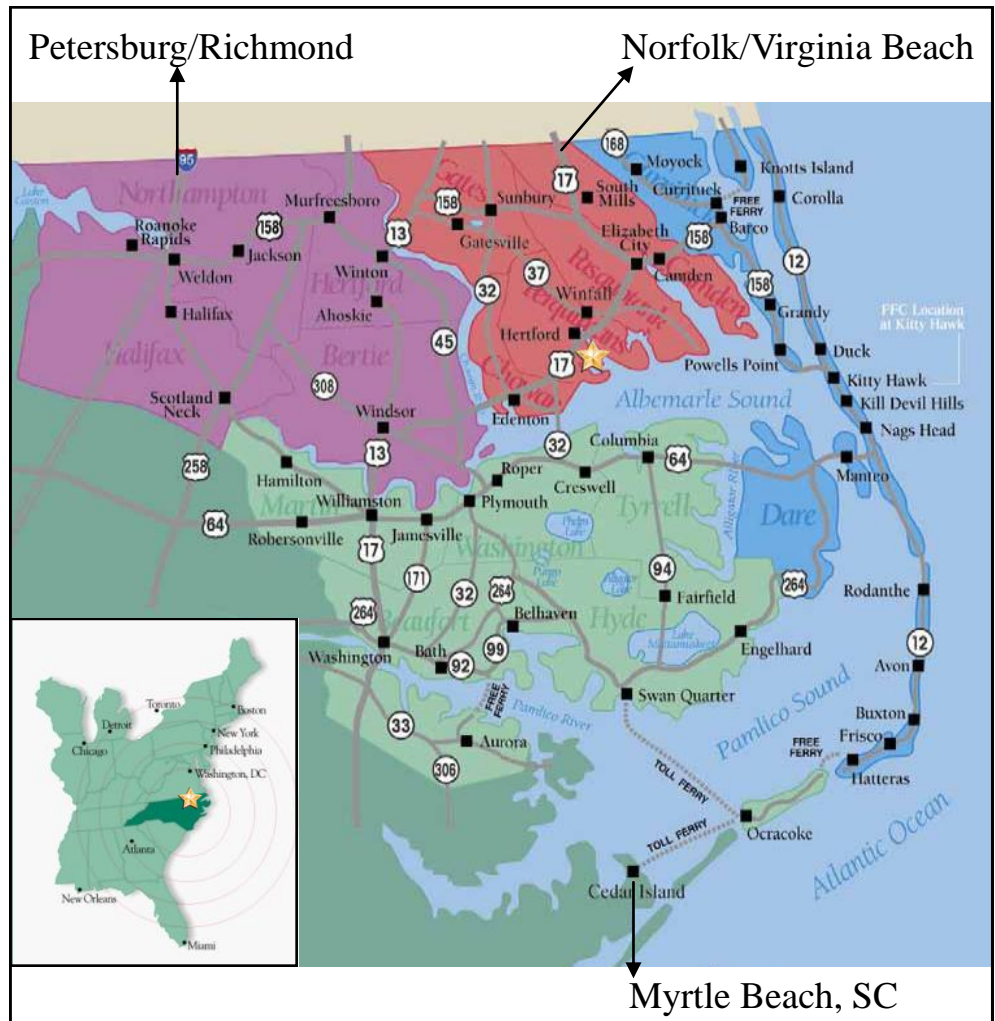
